Auckland Thoroughbred Racing (ATR) is an Incorporated Society, created by the amalgamation of Auckland Racing Club and Counties Racing Club on 1 August 2021.

ATR's purpose is to facilitate and promote Thoroughbred Racing in the Auckland Region.

ATR is committed to operating to high standards of environmental responsibility and establishing itself as an industry leader and advocate for sustainable racing practices in New Zealand.

ATR's will strive for best practice and embedding environmental performance across all sites and activities, management and operational teams, and business relationships.

No aspect of our organisation is excluded, however primary areas of focus are:

- reducing our climate impact from buildings, events, equipment, transport and travel;
- minimise waste and resource use through reduction and efficiency measures;
- integrating sustainability requirements into procurement and supplier contracts;
- pollution prevention and conscientious chemical management;
- regulatory compliance, emergency preparedness and response.

We seek to continually improve what we do and how we do it to protect the environment.

Our strategy to achieve this includes:

- developing activity within a nationally recognised and independently audited environmental management system (Toitu Enviro-mark);
- training, educating and engaging stakeholders to embrace our goals;
- setting expectations for employees, contractors and business partners;
- monitoring and reporting performance;
- evaluating risks, incidents and opportunities;
- establishing specific targets for focus areas.
